5. **The deadline for applications is Sunday May 10, 2015.**
6. At its discretion the Bursary Committee may request an interview.
7. The selected applicant will be announced and the bursary award presented on **May 24, 2015** at the CCA Annual General Meeting. The recipient's presence at the AGM will be requested but is not required.
8. If the Bursary Committee determines that no applicant meets the criteria then no Bursary will be awarded.
